Dr. Victor Pearce made an interesting observation:

"Remember that the Bible believer on his knees can see farther than the Bible sceptic on his tiptoes!"

So far, we have been looking solely at messianic prophecies leading up to the birth of Jesus, so that we can better understand the Nativity Narratives. We could sum these up as "the Who, the When and the Where" but we also need to consider the prophecies referring to the events of Easter

Josh McDowell in his book, "Evidence that demands a verdict" lists 61 major prophecies.

Did these 61 prophecies fully confirm Jesus as the Messiah, the Christ, the Son of God?

There are 2 main objections by sceptics:

1) Fulfilled Prophecy in Jesus was Deliberate

<u>BUT</u>: Eight main events were totally beyond the human control of Jesus: 1) place of birth; 2) time of birth; 3)manner of birth (born of a virgin); 4) betrayal; 5) manner of death; 6) people's reactions (mocking, spitting staring etc); 7) piercing by spear; 8) burial in rich man's tomb.

2) Fulfilled prophecy applied to Jesus could also have been applied to other people.

BUT: You might find just possibly one or two fulfilled in other men, but not all 61!!

The Christian Victory Publishing Company in Denver has offered \$1,000 to anyone who can claim to fulfil just 50% of the prophecies. Just think: there a lot of impoverished Bible

Students who could use some extra cash (myself included)!

It has been calculated that the probability of anyone living or dead who could have fulfilled <u>just 8</u> of the major prophecies are 1 in 100.000,000,000,000,000.

<u>In our list</u>: 1) no.10; 2) no.22; 3) no.27; 4) nos.33 & 44; 5) no.34; 6) nos. 35&36; 7) no.39; 8) nos.44 & 45 (crucifixion)

If we take that number of silver dollars and lay them on the state of Texas, they would cover the sate two feet deep in coins. We mark one of these dollars and stir all these dollars thoroughly and get a blindfolded man to pick just one coin and state that this is the right one, then it would be possible for anyone else, other than Jesus, living or dead to have fulfilled these 8 major prophecies!!!

The probability of someone else fulfilling 48 of these prophesies would be 1 chance in 10 What that would be like, well.... you really wouldn't want to go there!!!

Sceptics tell us that bible believing Christians are wishful thinkers who are willing to believe almost anything...maybe they should do the maths!!!

Isn't it strange that the real thinkers are the Christians and the real wishful thinkers are the sceptics? Not really: "Remember
